Semantics is involved with the meaning of words without considering the context whereas pragmatics analyses the meaning in relation to the relevant context. Thus, the key difference between semantics and pragmatics is the fact that semantics is context independent whereas pragmatic is context dependent.

Pragmatics is simply the study of use of language in context. Syntax is the study of the structural aspect of language by dealing with phrase and sentence formation. It basically deals with seeing ways through which words combine to form grammatical sentences. Structure of sentences is governed by rules of syntax.

Syntax —the rules that pertain to the ways in which words can be combined to form sentences in a language. Semantics —the meaning of words and combinations of words in a language. Pragmatics —the rules associated with the use of language in conversation and broader social situations.

Semantics contrasts with syntax, the study of the combinatorics of units of a language (without reference to their meaning), and pragmatics, the study of the relationships between the symbols of a language, their meaning, and the users of the language.

The main difference between semantics and pragmatics is that the semantics studies the meaning of words and their meaning within sentences whereas the pragmatics studies the same words and meanings but with emphasis on their context as well. Both semantics and pragmatics are two main branches of study in linguistics.
